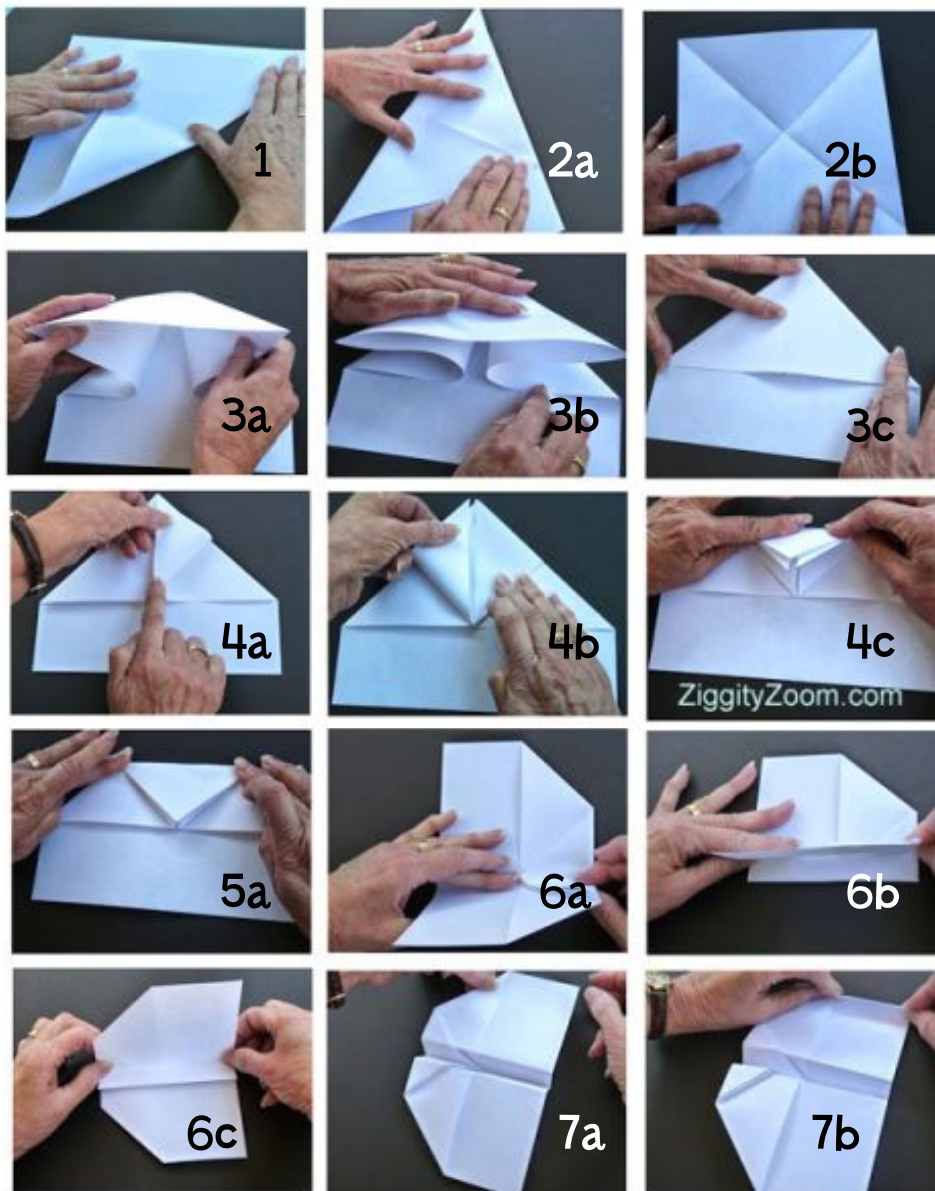


# HAWK RISING

## RED-TAILED HAWK GLIDER

He rides the wind  
like a wave,  
twisting and turning,

## DIRECTIONS

If it is not attached, you can find the hawk glider template by searching “hawk” at [CuriousCityDPW.com](http://CuriousCityDPW.com).

1. Folding to the white side of the template, fold the short side of the paper over to the right, even with the edge, and make a crease.
2. Unfold and repeat folding to the left.
3. Fold paper as shown to make a point, crease in place.
4. Fold each side tip, upward, to make a point.
5. Fold top point down now to meet the fold line. Crease well.
6. Fold plane in half and crease. Fold each wing back, leaving  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch at the bottom and crease.
7. Fold both outside edges up about  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and leave folded edge pointing upwards.

What changes can you make to the glider for a better flight? Use your STEM skills!
